FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Thank you. I am grateful to God for all of you. I am thankful that God called me here to Emmanuel fourteen years ago for so many reasons.

First of all, I am thankful for the people here both at the church and in the surrounding community. There are so many relationships that I will cherish and that's because you allowed me into your families and became a part of mine. There have been so many special people, but I wanted to give a few examples.

I remember Gus Gross would stop by our house with Snickers bars for the kids. One time, he even came to the house with two whole frozen chickens, which freaked out the kids! I remember the years when Peggy Lewis sat with Kristy and the kids at the Traditional service so that our littles would stay in the pew. According to our older children, that was before we went all soft and allowed Zoe to run around and dance to the songs! I remember Molly Lamborn always bringing special gifts to Micah because she didn't want him to feel left out since the older two were always involved in things. I remember youth Sundays when the only adult in the Praise Team was Kellie. There are so many people, some who are still alive and some who are not, that made a difference in our lives. My prayer is that we can continue to keep connected in the years to come because you will always be a part of our family.

I am thankful for all the times we were able to worship together. I have loved being able to lead you in worship with the guitar and singing. So many songs are connected to important moments in my faith life here. During the pandemic, when it was just five of us at church trying to keep worship services going, I recognized even more clearly how important it is to worship as a community. I am glad that so many of you have returned! Thank you for your grace when it took me most of the first year I was here to remember to sing the three-fold Amen at the Traditional service instead of

just saying it! I have tried to memorize even nook and cranny of the sanctuary so that I can remember what it felt like to worship with you, but I believe that it has been the presence of the Holy Spirit that truly made it special and we will still be worshipping the same God even though we will be in two different places.

I am thankful that you were able to put so much trust in me. You shared the darkest moments of your life with me and I truly hope that I was able to bring God's light into those times. I was able to share God's forgiveness with you when you confessed to the difficulties you were facing in your spiritual lives. You trusted me to share God's promise of salvation at many funerals and graveside services over the past fourteen years. We lived through a pandemic and a tornado together. Thank you for sharing so much of your lives with me.

Finally, I am thankful that I was able to learn from you and grow in faith alongside you. I know that I have not always been a perfect pastor. My sermons weren't always inspirational. I was not always the leader that you needed me to be either. However, you were understanding, forgiving and taught me how to trust God to lead me. I hope that I can take the lessons that I have learned here and translate them to do my best as the senior pastor at my next call in Le Mars.

Thank you for your love, your friendship and your faith. It has been an honor to serve you and to serve God alongside you. May the Lord bless you and keep you, may He make His face shine on you and be gracious to you. The Lord look upon you with favor and give you His peace. Amen.

E.L.C. COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES— JULY 14, 2024

The regular council meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Roger Jensen. Present: Judy Albers, George Feazell, Raedeen Bigelow, Rhonda Boehm, Gini Herr, Roger Jensen, John Baudler, and Louise Johnson. Absent: Pastor Steven Broers. Visitor: Denise Bridges.

Denise led devotions on how everyone has purpose in the lives of others.

Raedeen moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting June 15th as corrected and Rhonda seconded the motion. Motion carried.

George gave the treasurer's report for the month of June. Gini moved to approve the treasurer's report and John seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Pastor's monthly reports were reviewed and approved on motion by Gini and seconded by Raedeen. Motion carried. There were no emergency benevolence requests in June.

Ministry Reports presented:

Dave Huff and Kathi Christensen will be voting representatives at the LCMC Annual Gathering to be held September 29-October 2.

The 2025 Council Nomination Committee will be appointed at the semi-annual meeting July 21st.

New Business:

Council reviewed the Semi-Annual Meeting Agenda.

George presented the proposed 2025 Budget. Council discussed a couple of changes. Gini moved to present the 2025 budget at the semi-annual meeting for congregational approval and Judy seconded the motion. Motion carried. George reported the church received checks for tornado relief. Louise moved to give the checks to the Greater Greenfield Community Foundation and Judy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

George proposed 2nd quarter benevolence giving. Gini moved to approve the 2nd quarter proposed benevolence and to put on the semi-annual meeting agenda discussion about world benevolence for the 3rd and 4th quarters of 2024 going to tornado relief and to give \$1,500 to the NV Ministerial Association from the Designated Benevolence fund. George seconded the motion and the motion carried.

George reported the parsonage projects are tentatively scheduled to begin in September.

President Jensen moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. Motion carried.

President Jensen closed the meeting with the Lord's Prayer at 7:22 p.m.

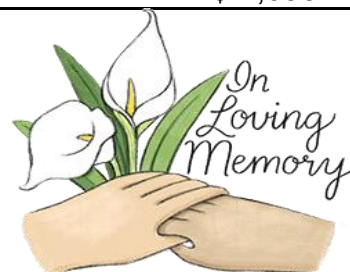

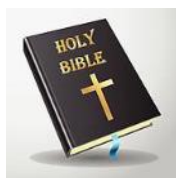

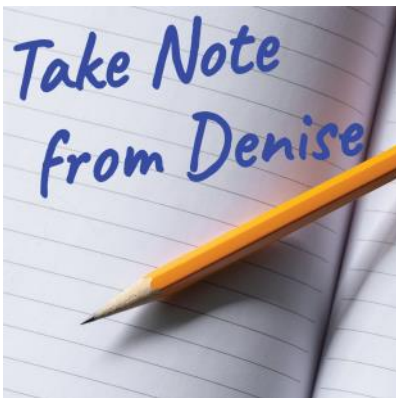
Confirmation Class Starts Soon!

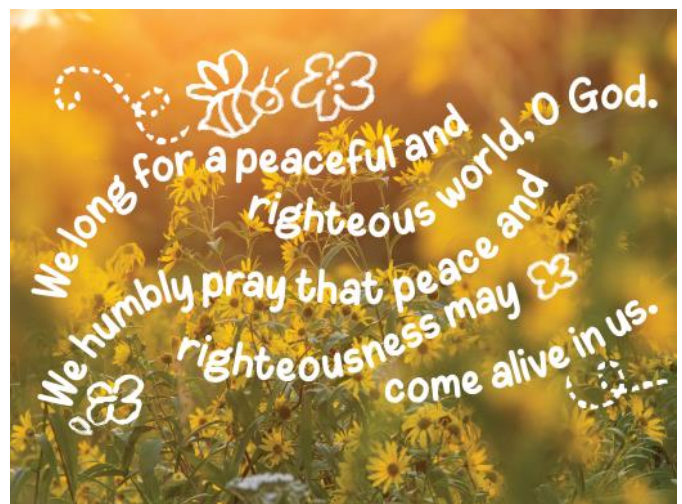
